GENERAL INFORMATION

a day on the green events are held outdoors on sites with terrain that consists of grass and uneven, rough surfaces. There is no shade or undercover areas, and the inclement weather can have a significant impact on the conditions of the site. We recommend taking this into consideration and reviewing the relevant venue's Event Site and Distances information within this guide.

Our events go ahead in wet weather unless conditions are deemed to be dangerous. If you have purchased an accessible ticket and have concerns regarding wet weather in the week leading up to the event, please contact us at info@roundhouse.com.au.

Patrons are advised that flicker, laser, strobe and other lighting effects may be in use at the event.

Carers

a day on the green is pleased to support the National Companion Card system. You can receive a complimentary ticket for a carer when booking your tickets via Ticketmaster's accessibility line on 1300 446 925. Please have your companion card handy when booking your ticket as well as bringing it along with you when attending the event. Please note there is a limit of one complimentary carer ticket per companion card.

We recommend bringing a carer who will be able to physically help you in navigating the event site and the uneven and rough terrain.

Guide & Service Dogs

Guide dogs, hearing dogs, or registered assistance and companion animals are allowed on site. For patrons attending with a guide or service dog, we ask that handlers carry appropriate identification/accreditation for the dog and for the dog to wear at all times their identification coat and harness/lead.

If you are purchasing Reserved Seating tickets, please contact Ticketmaster's accessibility line on 1300 446 925 and advise you require a complimentary seat for your service dog and at the event our team of ushers can assist in removing the chair for your service dog to sit comfortably with you in the reserved seating area. Please be aware patrons often stand / dance in front of their seats throughout the events.

Our venues can be very large sites where dogs will experience dense crowds, high levels of noise and laser, strobe and other lighting effects maybe in use at the event. We recommend guide and service dogs are not seated within the first front rows due to high sound volume and the dog's comfort and wellbeing.

Deaf & Hard of Hearing Patrons

Currently there are no shows scheduled with Auslan interpreters. For events where there is reserved seating, an allocation of seats within the front rows of the stage are available for purchase for patrons who are hard of hearing. Please contact Ticketmaster's accessibility line on 1300 446 925 to purchase these specific seats.

Limited Mobility Patrons

For events where there is reserved seating, an allocation of seats on the aisles are available for purchase to patrons with limited mobility. Please contact Ticketmaster's accessibility line on 1300 446 925 to purchase these specific seats.

Medications

Pass outs are not available, and patrons should bring any medications they require with them upon entry. Medications that require refrigeration can be stored at the first aid tents or contained in personal eskies (if the area your ticket is purchased for permits eskies). Please ensure all prescription medications are in original packaging with the dispensary label.

Temporary Impairment & Ailments

a day on the green will assist patrons with temporary impairments to the best of our ability, however, some patrons with temporary impairments may find the nature of the outdoor sites difficult to navigate.

Please note: ACCESSIBLE PARKING IS FOR DISABLED PARKING PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY.

Toilets

Accessible toilets are strategically located around the concert site. You can find them close to all patron toilet locations. We strive to keep these areas clean and sanitary to the best of our ability.

Vision Impaired Patrons

For events where there is reserved seating, an allocation of seats within the front rows of the stage are available for purchase for patrons who have vision impairment.

Those attending with a guide dog or service animal, please refer to the Guide / Service Dog information above. We recommend guide and service dogs are not seated within the first front rows due to high sound volume and the dog's comfort and wellbeing.

Wheelchair Patrons

Depending on the mode of event, wheelchair accessible tickets are available in the following areas.

Events with Reserved Seating and GA Lawn: Wheelchair tickets are available for purchase in the reserved seating area or in the GA Lawn area. There will be a designated wheelchair space in the GA Lawn area, and this will be signposted on the day with a blue wheelchair flag.

Events with Front GA Standing and GA Lawn: Wheelchair tickets are available for purchase in the Front GA Standing area or in the GA Lawn area. There is no designated wheelchair space in Front GA Standing area. GA Lawn area will have a designated wheelchair space, and this will be sign posted on the day with a blue wheelchair flag.

Accessible Parking

Accessible parking at Mt Duneed Estate is split into 2 designated accessible areas:

- Wheelchair Patrons will park via Gate C on Pettavel Road in proximity to Entrance 1.
- Limited mobility patrons who required accessible parking but do not require wheelchair-specific accessible parking, will park via Gate E or F via Pettavel Road. There will be signage indicating a meeting point near this parking area for buggy assistance to Entrance 2 entry gates. Due to demand for buggy service, only 1 additional guest can join accessible patrons on the buggy.
